Alternatively, you can select a beautiful stain that complements your décor. Each stain is also grain swept to add texture and pre-finished for durability and ease of installation.



Raw OAK

If you are inspired to create your own individual finish then you can select Raw Oak. The raw boards are completely uncoated allowing you to custom stain, wax or oil your floor for a unique bespoke result.



BOARD dimensions

Big River engineered Oak floor boards are available in a standard length of 1830mm and a standard width of 192mm. The flooring packs delivered to a site include 20% random lengths to assist in the flooring layout.

EASY TO install

Big River engineered Oak is supplied with machined tongue-and-groove joints that allow for quick and easy DIY installation. The boards can be glued, floating on underlay or stuck directly to the sub floor for a solid under-foot feeling.

EASY TO maintain

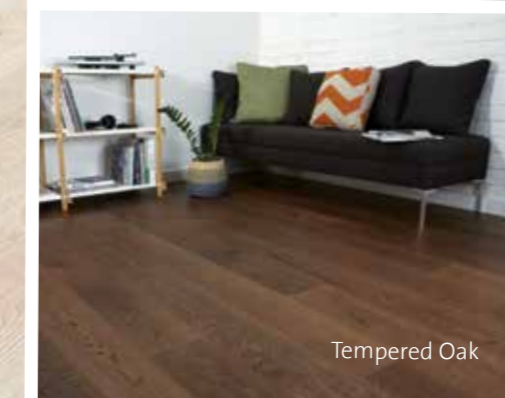
Big River engineered Oak flooring requires minimal maintenance. Regular sweeping or vacuuming to remove dust and grit plus wiping with a damp cloth that has been wrung dry is all that is required.



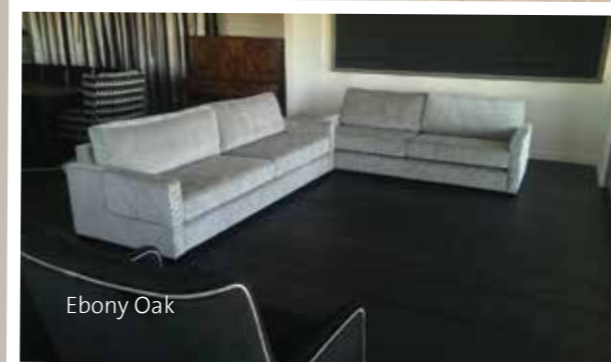

- Tongue & Groove – easy installation
- Micro-bevel edge – creates a small V-Shape between the boards for an authentic flooring finish

- More stable than solid timber planks
- Will not swell or shrink with changes in humidity
- Does not require top nailing
- Strength and hardness makes it ideal for heavy traffic areas
- Can be laid direct stick or as a floating floor
- Unlike most solid timber floors, it can be installed on virtually any flat surface – over concrete, tiles, or even existing timber floor boards
- Can be installed over underfloor heating.
